The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant a regular bail to him in case FIR No.60 dated 05.04.2023 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is aged about 75 years and is suffering from various old age related diseases. He further contends that he was arrested in the present case on 05.04.2023 and challan has already been presented against him in the Competent Court. While referring to the order Annexure P-2, dated 09.05.2023 passed by this Court, learned counsel submits that co-accused Baljit Kaur has already been granted the concession of bail in CRM-M-22327 of 2023. He further contends that there is no other case pending against him. Thus, the conclusion of the trial will take quite a long time.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the grant of concession of bail to the present petitioner. However, he does not dispute the fact that there is no other case against the present petitioner and conclusion of the trial will take quite a long time.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
