The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 25.06.2022, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC 1860, at Police Station, City 1, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 23.02.2023, the following order was passed by this Court.

“State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant, while praying for adjournment to argue the matter, submits that now one fresh FIR No.0033 dated 9.2.2023 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC has been registered against the present petitioner at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda.

Now be listed on 6.7.2023.

Interim order to continue. ”

Today the matter has been heard and the learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has been admitted to anticipatory bail by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda in the above stated case FIR No.0033 dated 9.2.2023 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda. He has also placed on record the photocopy of the order dated 18.04.2023 passed by the Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda and the same is taken on record.

In view of above, the interim order dated 01.08.2022 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
