The present petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 14.06.2023 whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Govt. Ayurvedic Dispensary, Quila Chowk, Patiala to Govt. Ayurvedic Dispensary Bishan Gargh, Tehsil Nabha, Distt. Patiala.

The petitioner assails the said transfer order on the ground that she is due to retire on August, 2024 and she is 40% permanently disabled.

I have considered the submissions.

It has been stated that therespondent has already joined on the place of posting viz a viz Patiala. This Court finds that the transfer order are within the same district and therefore, it can not be said that grave difficulty would arise for the petitioner who is physically handicapped. A person who is physically handicapped may not be transferred far of places but the posting within the District can not be objected to.

Counsel for the petitioner further insisted that the policy should be complied with certain law. The decision as laid down by the Apex Court in Mrs.Shilpi Bose and Othrs Vs State of Bihar and Othrs 91Supp.(2) SCC

the policy can not be implemented in the Court of law.

In view of the position explained above, the present writ petition is dismissed being devoid of merits.
