1. Vide order dated 16.12.2022, the status report filed by the State was ordered to be taken on record in which the following stand has been taken:-

“8. That after detailed enquiry, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Muktsar Sahib has concluded that:-

“Ass per my enquiry conducted till now it has bene established that none of the 'panchayati persons' present at the spot on 30.06.2022 have been found to have administered any medicine to the applicant Rupinder Kaur wife of Jagroop Chand resident of Lahorian Wali Basti, Jalalabad Road, Byepass Sri Muktsar Sahib. On the other hand, it has been found that Rupinder Kaur in order to retain the possession over the plot has herself consumed some poisonous substance and neither Rupinder Kaur has been found to have

purchased any land from her father Bhagwan Dass. As such there is no truth in the allegations raised by applicant Rupinder Kaur and for this reason it is recommended that the application be filed.” The enquiry report dated 22.08.2022 is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1.

2. In view of the aforesaid factual position, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press the present petition.
3. Disposed of accordingly.
