Instant Writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing notice, Annexure P-5, vide which, candidates were not called in the ratio of 1:3 of the total posts for interview in pursuance to Advertisement No.2 of 2015 for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical).

By an interim order passed by this Court on 27.01.2017, petitioner was provisionally interviewed. His result has been produced, which shows that the petitioner has got a total 106 marks, whereas the last candidate selected for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical) in EBPG category has secured 114 marks.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
