Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the transfer letter has not been issued in the name of the petitioner after the death of his father. The reason for non acceptance of the application was some unauthorized construction in the backyard.

Learned senior counsel for respondents No. 3 and 4 acknowledges the fact that the unauthorized construction which was made by the petitioner stands removed and there is no impediment for now to accept the prayer of the petitioner.

In the light of the above, impugned orders dated 01.02.1989 (Annexure P-1) and 09.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) and 11.08.2016 (Annexure P-5) are set aside and a direction is issued to the respondents No. 3 and 4 to proceed to finalize the transfer of the House No. HJ 92, Punjab Housing Development Board Colony, Ferozpur Road, Ludhiana.

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Petitioner would submit his application for revival of his earlier application within a period of one week.

Needful be done within a period of four weeks thereafter.
