Present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner
with a prayer to place on record the affidavit of Jatinderbir Singh-
complainant in FIR No.240 dated 22.09.2021 and affidavit of Varinder
Singh.

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Allowed as prayed for.

Affidavits Annexures P-8 and P-9 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Main cases

Since identical questions of law and facts are involved in all the above said petitions, the same are being disposed of by this common order.

The petitioners have filed the present petition praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.240 dated 22.09.2021, under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners have submitted that petitioners have already joined the investigation. He further submits that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners. Moreover, the parties have entered into a compromise. The complainant Jatinderbir Singh and injured Varinder Singh have sworn the affidavits as Annexure P-8 & P-9 regarding compromise. They both have stated that they do not want to take any action against the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Singh, 848/Amritsar, states that the petitioners have already joined the investigation and they are not required for any custodial interrogation.

Heard.

Although it is *inter alia* a case under Section 307 IPC but there is also cross version. Merit of the case is not to be seen at this stage. Although, compromise is not a ground to grant anticipatory bail in such cases but keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have already been

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granted interim bail and no recovery is to be effected from them and the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required. Accordingly, the orders granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute. The petitioners shall abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

All the three petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
