1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC for placing on record affidavit of the petitioner and some documents as Annexures A-1 to A-6.

2. Allowed as prayed for.

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3. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.03.2022 passed in CWP-PIL-76-2019.

4. Fresh status report dated 18.08.2023 by way of affidavit of Dilraj Singh, IAS, Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Transport, Chandigarh, has been filed, which shows that bus-stand in question has been made operational. Even the photographs showing the buses standing on the bus-stand have been placed on record. However, there is no direction in the order dated 22.03.2022 to ensure a minimum

volume of traffic at the bus stand. Therefore, no aspect of the order is left uncomplid with, except a general statement which was inserted in the order that no incorrect statement has been made before the Court.

5. In view of the above, finding no ground to interfere in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
