This writ petition in the nature of Mandamus is filed seeking directions to respondents No. 2 to 7 to initiate action against respondent No.8.

The grievance is that the representations dated 10.8.2020, 21.7.2020, 31.8.2020 and legal notice dated 5.10.2020 are not being considered.

Learned State counsel submits that the action has already been taken against respondent No.8, however, submits that legal notice would be considered and decided in accordance with law expeditiously.

In view of above, the petition is disposed of with directions that let the legal notice Annexure P-8 be decided by respondent No.5 within four weeks from today.

Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law if aggrieved of the decision on the legal notice.

Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
