The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance a writ in the nature of prohibition to restrain the respondents from closing the Railways Level Crossing bearing No. C-16 on Phagwara Banga Railway Line on the road from the Phagwara Banga Road leading to Villages Chak Mai Dass, Sarhla Ranua, Chak Guru etc.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in view of the written statement filed on behalf of the respondents and a policy decision taken by the respondents-Northern Railway to close all unmanned Railway Crossing he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.
