After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two of the advertised posts of the Station Supervisors are still lying vacant with the respondents and as the petitioner has competed and has secured more marks than the last selected candidate in the BC-A Category, the petitioner intends to approach the respondents with a prayer that keeping in view the fact that he had already attached all the relevant documents to support the reservation in the reserved category of BC-A and he had inadvertently mentioned his category as BC-B in the application form, his claim be considered under the BC-A Category and be given appointment having more marks in the said Category against the two posts, which are lying vacant.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation.

Learned State counsel submits that the result, which has been brought has been opened and the same be allowed to return to the respondents after sealing the same.
