1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking exercise of inherent jurisdiction of this Court for quashing of FIR No.202 dated 29.06.2020, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Sector-14, Gurugram.
2. Reply dated 21.08.2023 by way of an affidavit of Kapil Ahlwat, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Old Gurugram has been filed by learned State counsel. The same is taken on record. He submits that the charges have also been framed under Section 406 IPC, though the FIR was registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC.
3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to raise all pleas before the learned trial Court at appropriate stage.
