The learned counsel representing the petitioners submit that the petitioners are claiming right only on the basis of discrimination as the petitioners in writ petition bearing No.CWP-4261-2014 have been kept in service.

On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the respondents submit that they were kept in service only because of the interim order passed by this Court. In view of para 14 of the written statement filed by the respondent No.4 and 5, the service of respondent

No.4 were dispensed with on 16.09.2013. The learned counsel representing

respondent no.4 and 5 further submits that respondent No.5 has already submitted his resignation.

Subsequently CWP-4261-2014 has been dismissed. Hence, the interim order stands vacated.

Hence, there is no substance in the writ petitions.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
