1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that their services have not been extended though, as per the instructions dated 08.04.2016, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-3, the details of the petitioners were to be sent to the Head Office for continuation of the employees in service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners have raised the claim by filing a representation under the instructions dated 08.04.2016 (Annexure P-3) but the same has not been considered by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the representations of the petitioners, which have been collectively attached as Annexure P-11 be decided by the respondents keeping in view the instructions of the Government dated 08.04.2016

(Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner so that the petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in case no order has been passed on the representations of the petitioners which have been collectively attached as Annexure P-11 and the same are still pending consideration, appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks and in case after the decision of the representation, any benefit is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will also be extended to them within a further period of four weeks.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

5. Ordered accordingly.
