As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.2,58,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to all the three appellants in equal share, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit three chequea in the sum of Rs.86,000/- each (Rs.2,58,000/- in total) favouring appellants 1 to 3- Tej Kaur Wd/o Shri Mara Singh, Bhola Singh S/o Mara Singh and Gurjant Singh S/o Mara Singh, subject to all just exception, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
