The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent no.2 to conduct fair enquiry on the complaint dated 01.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) submitted to respondent no.2 against respondents no.3 and 4.

On issuance of notice of motion, short reply by way of affidavit dated 18.03.2021 of Deepinder Kaur, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (H.Q.), NRI Wing, District SAS Nagar, has been filed on behalf of respondent nos.1 and 2, wherein it has been stated that the complaint (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner was duly enquired into by the deponent and finding dispute between the parties is of civil nature and the fact that the cause of action, if any, arose in Chandigarh, the recommendation was made by the deponent to file the complaint of the petitioner and consequently the same was filed. Learned State counsel further submits that since the complaint of the petitioner has already been enquired into, therefore, the present petition has been infructuous.
