Appeal is against the judgment of acquittal dated 05.03.2018 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge / Special Judge, Sonapat, acquitting respondents No.1 to 5 of the charges framed against them under Sections 323, 376, 377, 506, 498-A and 511 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, Police Station Sadar, Sonipat.

2. Vide order dated 03.07.2019, the application for leave to appeal was granted and appeal was ordered to be registered and admitted. Pursuant thereto an application bearing No.CRM-23573-2023 has been filed praying for permission to withdraw the appeal in view of the parties having settled their dispute amicably and resolved to withdraw all pending litigations, as per joint statement dated 18.05.2022 suffered before the learned Family Court, Sonapat, Annexure A/1.

3. Notice of the application (CRM-23573-2023) to respondent No.6 – State only.

4. Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6 – State and states that he has no objection to the prayer of the applicant / appellant.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, the application is allowed and main appeal dismissed as withdrawn.
