The petitioner had filed the present petition before this Court with the prayer to direct the respondents no.1 to 3 to protect them from the threatening and harassment being caused to them by respondents No.4 to 6 at behest of respondent No.7.

Notice of motion was issued in this matter and a short reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Khadoor Sahib, Camp at Goindwal Sahib, Tarn Taran on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 6 was filed in the Court. Learned State counsel submits that the representation dated 23.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) was submitted before the office of respondent No.3 by levelling allegations of cheating against respondent No.7- Lakhbir Singh and respondent No.3 had marked the said representation to the Incharge, Economic Offences Wing for conducting fair and impartial inquiry in the present case. The said officer conducted the inquiry and recorded the statements of both the parties and it was found that both the parties i.e. the petitioner as well as

respondent No.7 have instituted the complaint before the Court of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khadoor Sahib, Tarn Taran against each other and the said cases are pending before the learned Court. Consequently, the enquiry officer recommended the filing of the representation and the findings of the enquiry officer have been duly approved by respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran. Still further, it has been found on record that there is no threat to life and liberty of the petitioner and in case, any representation is made by the petitioner, appropriate action will be taken in accordance with law.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, there is no necessity of passing further orders and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
