Main case

While praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to quash the order dated 23.12.2013, the petitioner claims that his suspension period is required to be counted towards the qualifying service for pensionary benefits. He submits that no specific order has been passed by the disciplinary authority in this regard.

Learned State counsel admits the aforesaid fact and submits that a speaking order is required to be passed in this regard. He submits that an opportunity be granted to the disciplinary authority to pass an appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the disciplinary authority to pass a

speaking order, after considering all aspects of the matter, within a period of one month, after granting the opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
