1. This petition was filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 277 dated 17.12.2016 under Sections 420/120-B IPC, 1860 registered at P.S. Division No. 7, District Ludhiana and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
2. Learned counsel for the State submits that trial has begun.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State is not pressing this petition with liberty to approach the Trial Court for expeditious conclusion of the trial.
4. Petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
5. Since the main case has been dismissed as not pressed the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
