Vide order dated 01.12.2022, on behalf of the appellants,
proposal was made to enhance compensation by ₹36,29,000/- over and
above the amount awarded by the MACT in full and final settlement of the
claim in this appeal and the matter was adjourned for concurrence of the
respondent - Insurance Company.

Today, learned counsel and representatives of respondent No.3
- Insurance Company state that Company is agreeable to pay only an
amount of ₹33,75,000/- and not ₹36,29,000/- over and above the amount
awarded by the MACT. This counter-offer of ₹33,75,000/- has been
accepted by appellant No.1 and learned counsel for the appellants, who have
signed the statement.

Thus, as agreed, as per statements of appellant No.1, learned
counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representatives of the
respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of
₹33,75,000/- (₹ Thirty Three Lakh Seventy Five Thousand Only) over and
above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in
full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of

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learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 - Gurmeet Kaur alias Harpreet Kaur widow of Amrik Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹33,75,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 - Gurmeet Kaur alias Harpreet Kaur widow of Amrik Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 23.02.2023, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant (s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
