The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.183 dated 29.05.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 353 of the IPC, 1860 and Section 25-54-59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal.

2. As per the prosecution allegations, petitioner was being chased by the police party to be apprehended in some case, when he allegedly fired in direction of police party. Though no police official was injured but one of the bullet hit the windscreen of the police vehicle and other to the bullet proof jacket of one of the police official. In the process when the firing was being done, petitioner also sustained gun shot injury from the police.

3. It is contended by learned counsel that no injury was caused to any of the police official. It is further pointed out that in the FIR there is no mention of the case in which petitioner was being sought to be apprehended by the police. Petitioner is in custody for the last more than one year. Charges have been framed and trial may take long time to conclude and so,

he be granted bail.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State. Bail is opposed on the ground that petitioner is involved in 2 more cases. However, contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner are not refuted.
6. Learned State counsel has placed on record custody certificate as per which petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year 01 month and 09 days.
7. Having regard the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
