The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to ensure strict compliance of Notification issued vide Circular No.RBI/2006-07/138 DNBS (PD) CC No.80/03.10.042/2005-06 dated 28.09.2006 (Annexure P-8) and also for directing respondents No.5 and 6 to release the vehicle No.PB-13-AF/2656 which is alleged to have been illegally detained.

It is evident from a perusal of the order sheets that there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner for the last two dates in succession.

Vide order dated 27.07.2022 last opportunity was granted to the learned counsel for the petitioner to address arguments.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner even today.
