The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.235 dated 09.05.2020 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered with Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Punjab).

None appears on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 18.01.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation. He also admits that a compromise has been effected between the parties.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.01.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
