1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the impugned order dated 20.05.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.1 and order dated 18.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) vide which respondents No.1 and 2 have awarded the maintenance to the tune of Rs.10,000/- per month in favour of respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has pointed out that in the present case, notice of motion was issued on 23.11.2016 primarily on the argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioner that there are chances of amicable settlement between the parties. It is stated that inspite of the fact that the matter was referred to the Mediation Centre, the petitioner has not settled the matter with respondent No.3, who is the

widowed mother of the petitioner.

3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
