JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 2 to decide representation dated 07.10.2020.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner has made representation dated 01.10.2020 which was followed by various representations but respondents are not paying heed to representations of the petitioner.

3. The prayer made in the representation is as below:

“In view of the above-mentioned facts and settled law, it is humbly prayed that the Hon’ble Competent authority may kindly be pleased to pass the following orders:-

(a) To quash the order under which following punishment was meted out to the petitioner by the CO on 05.02.2020:-

(i) Severe Reprimand.

(ii) 14 days’ pay fine.

(b) Reimbursement of amount deducted in

care of 14 days' pay fine from the salary of April 2020 of the petitioner.

(c) Grant of entitled MACP to the rank of Hony Naib Subedar as the petitioner would have been entitled to; had the punishment, mentioned at Para 18 (i) and (ii) not been wrongly meted out to him.

(d) To cancel and republish the Part II order in respect of the petitioner under which 54 days of Annual Leave was published for the year 2020; instead of 30 days of Casual Leave and 24 days of Special Leave contrary to the directions of the Govt. Also, the Part-II order for 24 days of leave encashment for the year 2020 be published.

(e) Any other relief deemed fit by the Hon'ble Competent Authority in the light of circumstances in the present case."

4. Ms. Saigeeta Srivastava, learned counsel for the respondents submits that respondent would pass an appropriate order on representations of the petitioner within a period of 6 weeks from today.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition stands disposed of.
