The petitioner-Corporation alleges violation of the order dated 14.09.2018, passed by this Court in ***CWP-27915-2017***, titled as ***Harbhajan Singh vs. Union Territory of Chandigarh and others***, wherein an undertaking was given by respondent No. 1 Harbhajan Singh that he will pay the charges to the respondents as per norms fixed by the administration for the services availed by him for staying in the Old Age Home.

A perusal of the order dated 13.12.2017 would reflect that the petitioner, who at that time was aged about 79 years, was staying in the Old Age Home, Sector 15, Chandigarh and alleged that he was turned out of the same because of the complaint made by other inmates.

It is fairly conceded that respondent No. 1 Harbhajan Singh has

died.

In view of the personal undertaking given by the said respondent through his counsel, who had stated at bar to clear the dues, if any, and also in view of the fact that respondent Harbhajan Singh has already died, this contempt petition does not survive anymore.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed.

Rule stands discharged.
