The limited question for which the petitioner has come up before this Court is for Transfer the trial of Criminal Complaint case Nact 2248 of 2017 dated 11.12.2017 (P-02) and Nact 2268 of 2017 dated 15.12.2017 (P-03) of 138 of Negotiable instrument Act Titled as “Deepa Kumar Versus Harshpinder Singh” filed by Respondent no 2 pending in the court of Learned JMIC Abohar and transferred to the court of Learned SDJM Abohar or vice versa, where the connected case of same dispute is pending having Challan Number CHI/0000428 of 2021 Titled as "State of Punjab Versus Deepak Soni” Regarding FIR number 143 Dated 05.09.2018, registered under section 406, 120-B of IPC Police Station City Abohar (P-04) on behalf of the petitioner and respondents no 2 & 3 are the Accused in the said FIR.

Counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submitted that he has no objection in case the petition is allowed.

Given above, the petition stands allowed. Concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate to ensure the listing of both the complaints i.e. NACT 2248 of 2017 and NACT 2268 of 2017, before the Court where the connected case bearing FIR No. 143 Dated 05.09.2018, registered under section 406, 120-B of IPC Police Station City Abohar, is pending.
