The petitioner herein has sought the relief of regular bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.227 dated 08.09.2021 registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur, under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted the Custody-Certificate of the petitioner in the Court today and the same is taken on the record.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while praying that the petitioner is behind the bars in connection with the criminal case under reference, since 08.09.2021 and therefore, the trial Court be directed to conclude the trial and to decide the said case at the earliest possible.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection in the withdrawal of the present petition as well as to the above-discussed prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
