1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of respondents vide which the petitioner has been dismissed from the service.

2. Learned State Counsel has pointed out that in para 17 of the present writ petition, it has been stated that the petitioner has no other alternative remedy whereas he has right to file appeal under Rule 16.29 of the Punjab Police Rules as applicable to the State of Haryana.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
