Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to take immediate action upon representations submitted by the petitioner and further to take possession of the land owned by the private respondents beyond permissible area by declaring it as surplus in accordance with provisions of the Punjab Land Reforms Act, 1972. Further prayer has been made to direct the official respondents to set aside/quash the sale deeds Annexures P-2, P-5 and P-13 as same have been executed in contravention to Section 4(5) of the Land Reforms Act, 1972.

Written statement on behalf of respondent No.7 has been filed, which is taken on record.

It has been submitted by learned counsel respondent No.7 that on the representation filed by the petitioner, respondents have already passed an order. He submits that the order passed by the respondents has already been assailed by the petitioner by way of filing an appeal before the Commissioner and the same was dismissed. He submits that now the petitioner has filed ROR No.1239 of 2023, which is pending adjudication before Financial Commissioner for 15.01.2024.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all his grievances in the revision filed before the Financial Commissioner.
