SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner, who is working as a Kanungo, has not been permitted to appear in the departmental examination for promotion to the post of the Naib Tehsildar.

2. State counsel has placed on record a copy of Memo No.84-E-1-2020/8454 dated 26.04.2020, which is taken on record, relevant extract of which is reproduced as under:-

“2. The Government has reconsidered the whole matter and observed that passing of departmental examination by non Graduate Kanungos, District Revenue Accountants and Senior

Revenue Accountant would not give them any right or privilege to claim out of turn promotion as Naib Tehsildar merely on the basis of having passed the examination. The promotion rules would remain unchanged and Kanungos, District Revenue Accountants and Senior Revenue Accountant would continue to be promoted as Naib Tehsildar on the basis of seniority-cum-merit irrespective of the fact whether they had passed the Naib Tehsildar Examination or not.

3. The Government has, therefore, decided to withdraw the letter issued vide Memo No.769-E-1-2018/5968, dated 06.07.2018 to the extent that only Graduate Kanungos, District Revenue Accountants and Senior Revenue Accountant are eligible to appear in the prerequisite departmental examination of the Naib Tehsildar.”

3. In view of above, counsel for the petitioner states that the petition has become infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
