1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to rectify the date of birth in the E-Certificate and score card and further directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 23.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) within some specified time.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the grievances raised by the petitioner, the petitioner has given representation dated 23.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.2 and prays that respondent No.2 be directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and

limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2 to consider representation dated 23.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

4. It is made clear that in case, respondent No.2 is of the opinion that the plea raised by the petitioner is meritorious then the necessary relief, in accordance with law, would be granted to the petitioner within a period of one month thereafter and in case, respondent No.2 is of the opinion that the pleas raised by the petitioner are not meritorious then the same be rejected by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
