1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.54, dated 08.03.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Section 379-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, Teshil & District Amritsar (Police commissionerate Amritsar), Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered against unknown person. The allegation is of snatching of mobile phone. Learned counsel submits that the mobile phone alleged to have been already stands recovered. Investigation stands concluded and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C already stands filed and the petitioner has suffered incarceration for more than 04 months and 19 days.

3. The aforesaid assertions made by learned counsel for the petitioner

has not been controverted by counsel for the State.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

6. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
