The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.435 dated 02.12.2021 registered under Sections 452, 326, 148, 149 & 506 of the IPC registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Power of attorney on behalf of complainant-injured Harman Sharma has been filed by Mr. Monty Goyal, Advocate, which is taken on record.

As per the custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 11 months and 9 days.

It is submitted by learned counsels for both the sides that matter has since been compromised and that they will file the quashing petition soon.

Having regard to the custody period of the petitioner and that matter has already been compromised between the parties, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction
