1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.61 dated 03.03.2023, registered under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar.
2. Vide order dated 07.07.2023, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 07.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 07.07.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
