Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.2 whereby the application of the petitioner for allotment/transfer of government House No.25-D, Model Town, Patiala in her name under Rule 24 of the Punjab Government Houses (General Pool) Allotment Rules, 1983 has been rejected.
