The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0096 dated 01.06.2022 registered under Sections 419, 420, 120-B, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.08.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
