The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to stop illegal plying of unauthorized vehicles beyond the jurisdiction of their permit.

Status report by way of affidavit of Rohtash Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind (Law and Order), District Jind, dated 02.07.2022 has been filed wherein the respondents-authority have delineated the action taken by them against the violators of Section 192-A and Section 207 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988. It is further submitted that such action shall continue to be taken against the violators in future as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in view of the aforesaid information furnished by the respondents and the stand taken by them, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
