MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner herein seeks the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect her and her family members' lives and liberty and also to register the FIR against respondents No.4 to 6 under Sections 376 and 506 IPC.

2. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as regards the relief qua the protection of the lives and liberty of the petitioner and her family members, she (petitioner) would move a fresh representation to respondent No.2, exclusively praying therein for the said protection and so far as the remaining relief, as sought by her in the instant petition, is concerned, she (petitioner) would resort to the appropriate, alternative and efficacious remedy, as may be permissible to her under law, for this purpose and he further prays that respondent No.2 be directed to look into and take appropriate action on the fresh representation of the petitioner within some

specific time frame and the present petition may be disposed of accordingly.

3. Mr. Iqbal Singh Mann, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Resultantly, without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the petition in hand, the same is hereby disposed of in terms of the afore-mentioned submissions, as made by learned counsel for the petitioner, with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali that in case, the petitioner moves any fresh representation to him, restricting her prayer therein to the protection of her and her family members' lives and liberty only, he shall look into the same and if the prayer of the petitioner would be found to be a genuine one, then he shall take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the matter, within two weeks thereafter.
