This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order of final partition dated 18.08.2015 (Annexure P-5), order dated 01.04.2016 (Annexure P-7) and order dated 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-10).

Learned counsel for respondent no.4 has referred to the order dated 03.03.2020 which reads as under:-

“Service is not complete. One last opportunity was granted vide order dated 03.09.2019. Yet, the needful has not been done.

Adjourned finally to 16.09.2020.

In case, the needful is not done before the next date of hearing, the petition shall be liable to be dismissed for non-prosecution.
