1. The petitioner Kanwar Rani Sardana has filed petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for deciding application dated 04.05.2022 filed under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 CPC for grant of ad-interim injunction in CS-589-2022 titled Kanwar Rani Sardana Vs. Suman Sardana and others with the prayer for issuing appropriate directions to the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Derabassi to decide the aforesaid application.

2. Status report from the Court of Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Derabassi, dated 23.08.2023, has been received which clearly indicates that notice of suit was given to the defendants. The defendant Nos. 1 to 4 filed their written statement on 18.11.2022 and defendant No.6 filed written statement on 26.04.2023. The defendant No.5 filed application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC and the case is pending for 06.09.2023 for filing reply by the plaintiff.

3. The aforesaid status report clearly indicates that at present the case is pending for filing reply to the application under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC which has to be filed by the present petitioner. After disposal of this application, the other application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 can be decided on merits.

Since the present petitioner is seeking ad-interim injunction, therefore, the learned trial Court is directed to proceed with the case as per law expeditiously.

The revision is disposed of accordingly.
