The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the stand taken by the respondent-University vide Annexure P-11 dated 04.02.2020 and for re-verification of the credentials of the selected candidates in the BCA category.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued, appearance have been caused on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 would submit that all the documents and credentials of the selected candidates have been re-verified and it was found that Raghubir-respondent No.8 did not possess the requisite certificates to acquire five marks under the socio-economic criteria. In view of the said finding, the appointment letter of Raghubir-respondent No.8 stands withdrawn and his services are terminated with immediate effect.

In view of the statement having been made above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant writ petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
