The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.79 dated 06.06.2023 under Sections 379, 447, 511, 427 & 34 IPC registered at Police Station Moonak District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 27.07.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurbhej Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 27.07.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 27.07.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is further made clear that in case the petitioners or anyone on their behalf attempts to interfere in the possession of the complainant, the complainant and the State are at liberty to move a petition for cancellation of bail granted by this Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
