The petitioners prays for the following substantive reliefs in the present writ petition, which are as under:-

“ (a) A writ of certiorari, for quashing the impugned order dated 11.10.2013 (Annexure P-9) whereby respondent No. 4 has permitted respondent No. 5 for taking back his request for retirement by withdrawing his previous order No. 74/SK/BC-1 dated 30.06.2010 (Annexure P-3).

For issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction directing respondent No. 3 to dispose of the representations dated 17.01.2014 (Annexure P-10) filed by the petitioners against the impugned order dated 11.10.2013 (Annexure P-9).

For issuance of any other appropriate writ, order, or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in view of the facts and circumstances of the case.”

Learned counsel representing the petitioners did not come forward to assist the Court. However, learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Amandeep Singh, Senior Assistant has submitted that the petitioners as well as respondent No. 5 on attaining the age of superannuation stand retired.

In view of the above, the writ petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, the petitioners shall have the liberty to file application for revival, if the facts are otherwise.
