1. This writ petition is filed aggrieved of order dated 27th January, 2021 whereby the stamp vender's licence of Ramesh Chand Sanghi was transferred in the name of his son Sandeep Sanghi.
2. The grievance is that the licence was transferred in violation of Punjab Stamp Rules 1934.
3. Learned counsel for respondents No. 1 to 4 defends the impugned order.
4. The impugned order is non speaking and the reasons cannot be substituted by the reply filed in the High Court. Consequently, the impugned order is set aside with the directions to respondent No. 3 to decide the issue afresh after providing opportunity to respondent No.6.
6. As an interim measure, the licence transferred in favour of respondent No. 6 shall continue till the decision is taken afresh by

from today.
