1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0011 dated 18.02.2023 for the offences under Sections 323, 324, 307, 341, 148, 149 IPC (Section 302 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Nurmehal, District Jalandhar Rural.
2. On the last date of hearing/on 26.07.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel, while drawing the attention of this Court to the allegations levelled in the FIR, which has been annexed as Annexure P-1, submits that a perusal of the same makes it abundantly clear that no role much less any injury has been attributed to the petitioner in the occurrence in question. Other than his presence having been shown in the car in which the co-accused traveled to the place of occurrence, no other role has been attributed to him. On a pointed query, learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has clean criminal antecedents and is not involved in any other case. he submits

that the petitioner is ready to join investigation.”

3. Learned State counsel also does not dispute that petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 26.07.2023, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

5. Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 26.07.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
