This is an application for placing on record the receipt dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure A-2) as well as orders dated 26.07.2023 and 08.09.2023 (Annexures A-3 and A-4) granting interim bail to the petitioners.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the aforesaid documents are taken on record.

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20.07.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for setting aside the impugned order dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Trial Court, Patti vide which the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he is ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 18.09.2023.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of one week from today and subject to her depositing Rs.25,000/- as costs with Spinal Rehabilitation Centre, Chandigarh Plot No.1, Madhya Marg, Sector 28- A, Chandigarh, she shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

A copy of the receipt with regard to deposit of Rs.25,000/- as cost as well as a copy of the zimni order of the Trial Court granting bail to the petitioner be placed/produced on the record on the next date of hearing”.

In deference to the aforementioned orders, both the petitioners have surrendered before the Trial Court and have since been released on interim bail. Further, an amount of Rs.25,000/- stands deposited.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioners shall henceforth not absent themselves from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
