1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 04.08.2021 passed by Additional Commissioner & Regional Director, Employees State Insurance Corporation.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent Nos.2 to 4, at the outset submits, that in terms of Section 14(3) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 read with Appendix VI, the petitioner has alternative remedy to approach Central Administrative Tribunal (for short 'CAT'). He further submits that if petitioner files a petition before CAT, the respondents would not raise question of limitation.

3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach CAT, Chandigarh Bench. He further prays that interim order dated 21.09.2021

passed by this Court may be continued till the filing of petition before CAT, Chandigarh Bench.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

Interim order dated 21.09.2021 passed by this Court shall remain in force for 30 days from today.
