ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed seeking cancellation of the regular bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 30.10.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-45366-2018.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the accused submits that bail may not be cancelled and he would have no in case stringent conditions are imposed on the accused.

Since the matter for cancellation of bail is pending from the last four years, and also given the submission of counsel for the accused, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the accused-respondent No.2 to adhere the following conditions:-

1. The accused-respondent No.2 shall not threaten, contact, call, text, message, remark, stare, stalk, make any gestures or express any unusual or inappropriate, verbal or otherwise objectionable behavior towards the complainant, either physically, or through phone call.

- 2. The accused-respondent No.2 shall not post any derogatory remarks on social media against the complainant.
- 3. The accused-respondent No.2 shall not publish any confidential documents against the complainant.

It is clarified that in case accused/respondent No.2 does not comply with the conditions as envisaged above, it shall be permissible for the State as well as to the complainant to file fresh petition for cancellation of bail.
